Looking Ahead

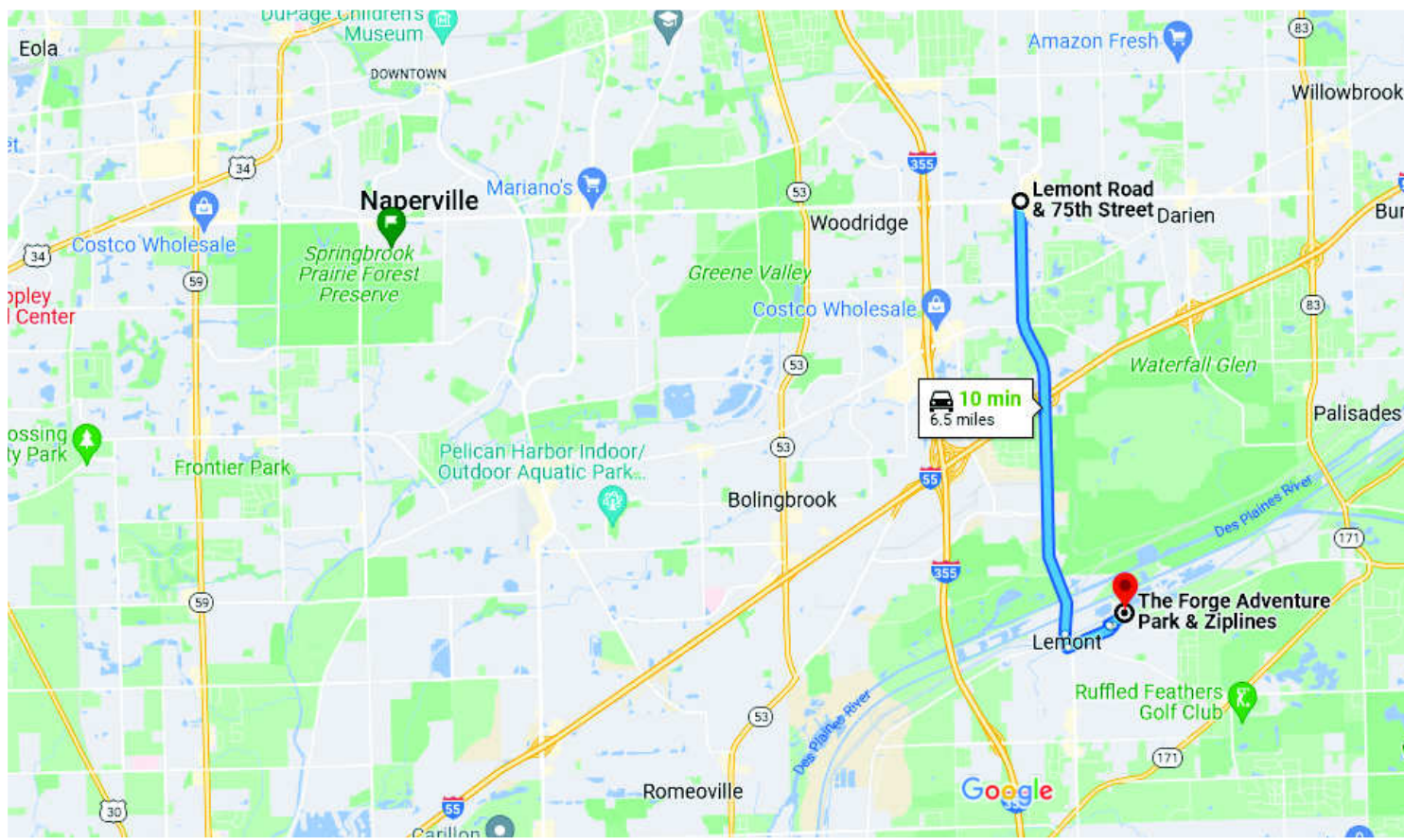
